

B50 She Gave All, Mark 12:38-44, Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

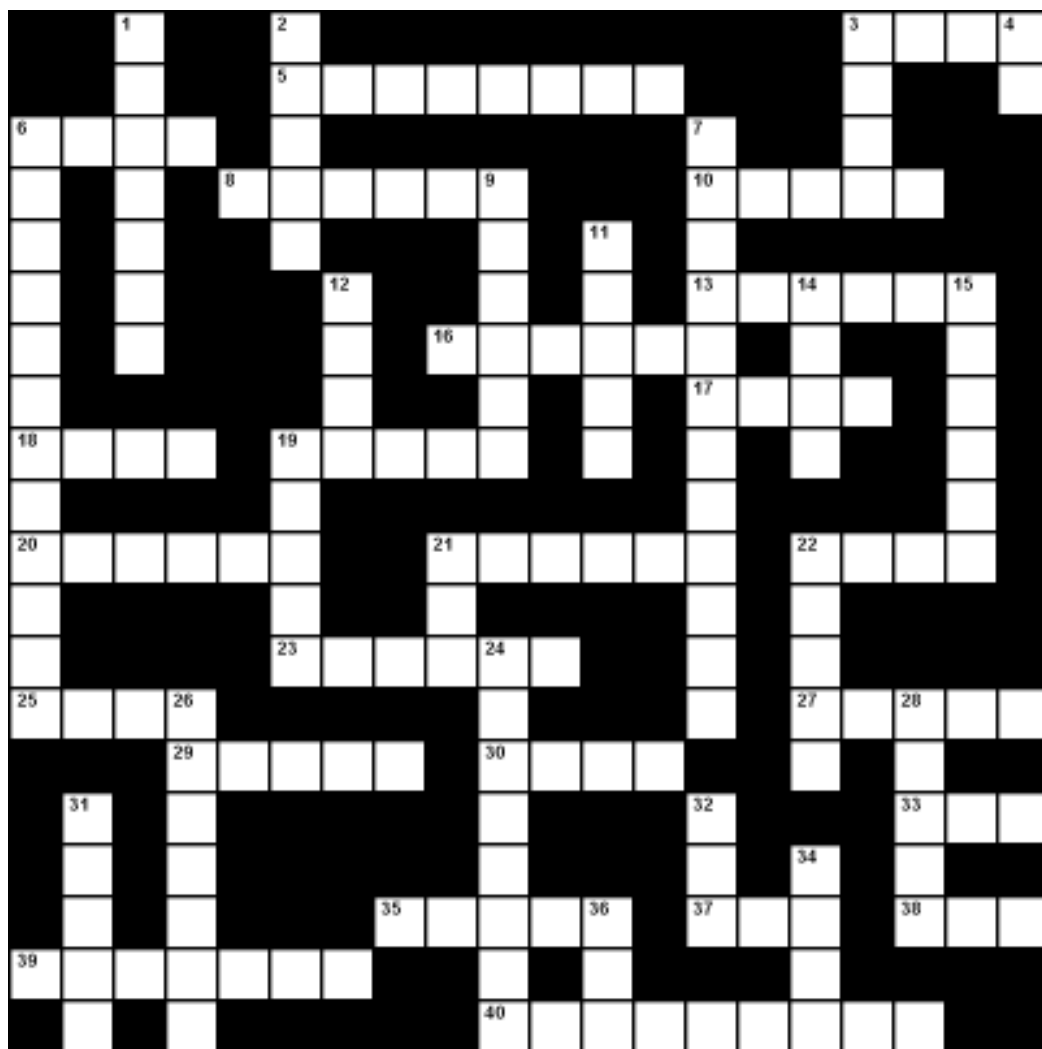
