Feast of Christ, the King**

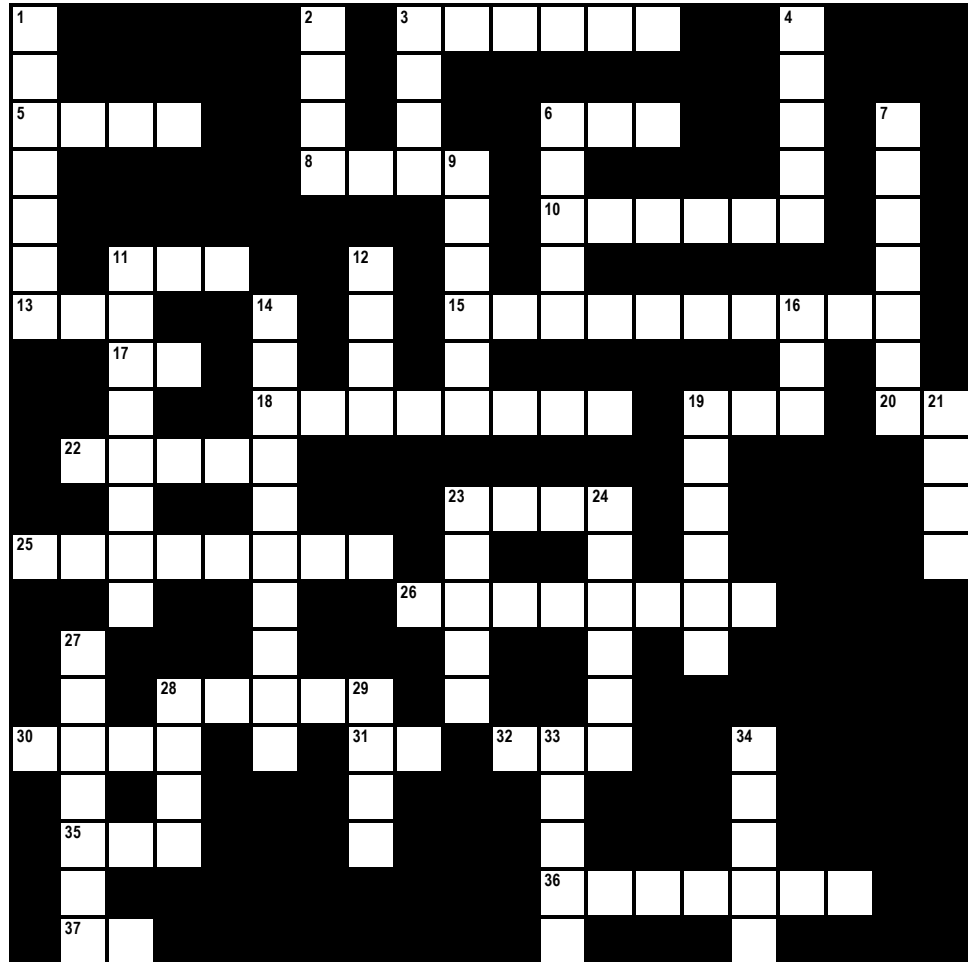
