Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time**

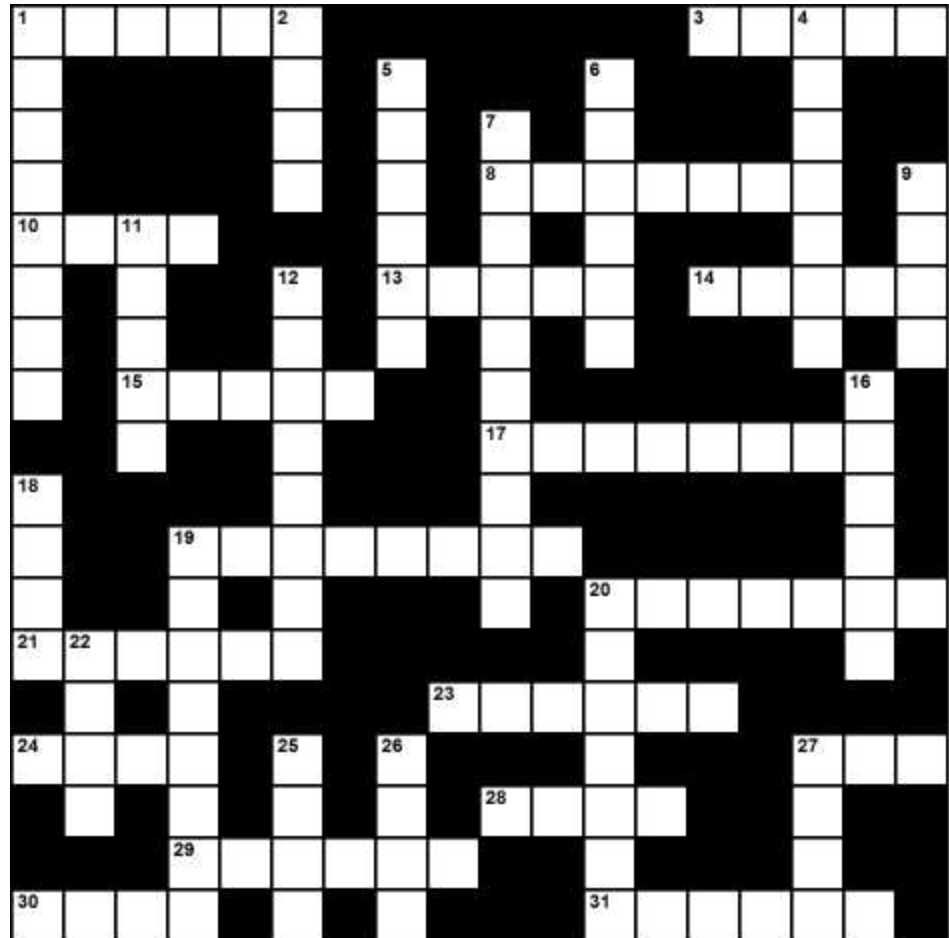
