

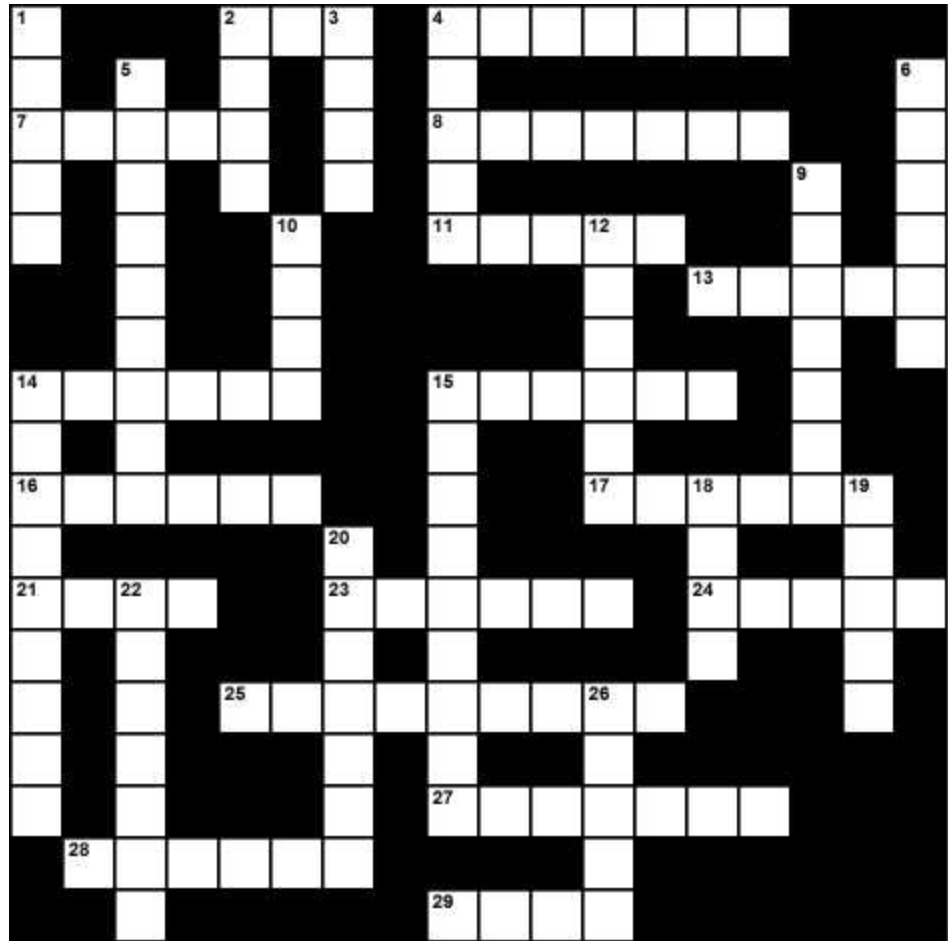
## C18 He Who Is Without Sin Throw the First Stone, John 8:1-11
