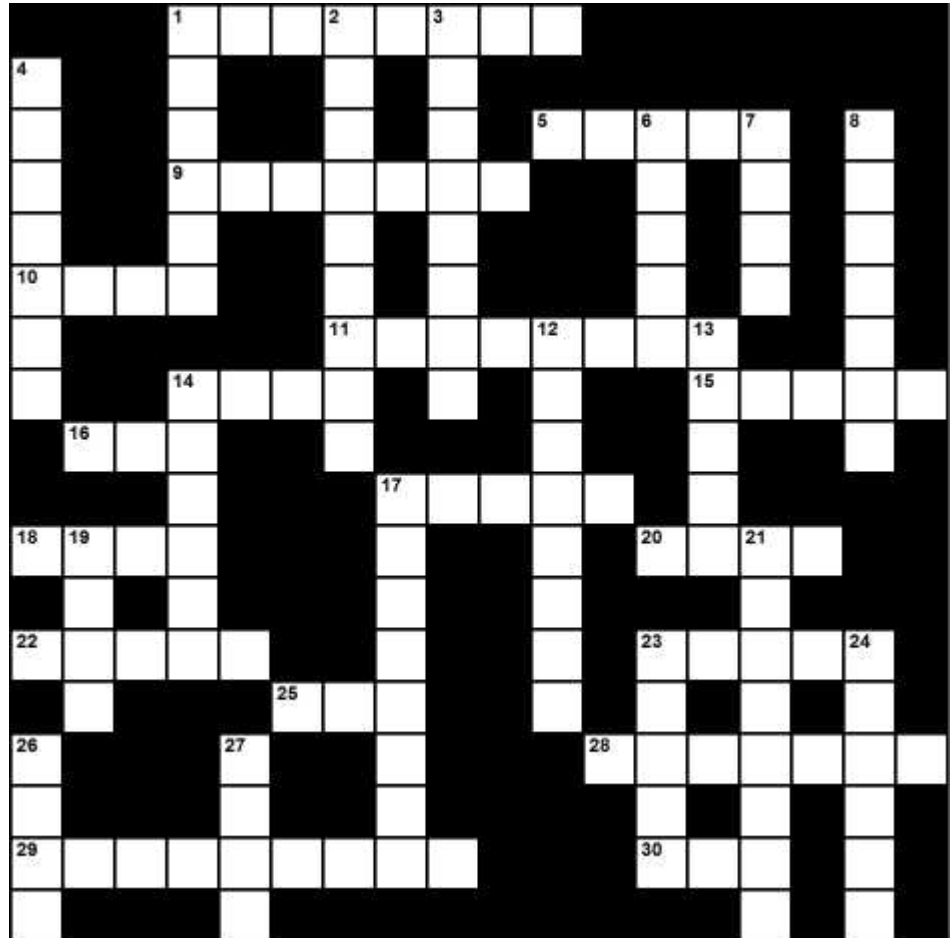


C19 Your Sins Are Gone Forever, Luke 22:14-71 and 23:1-56
