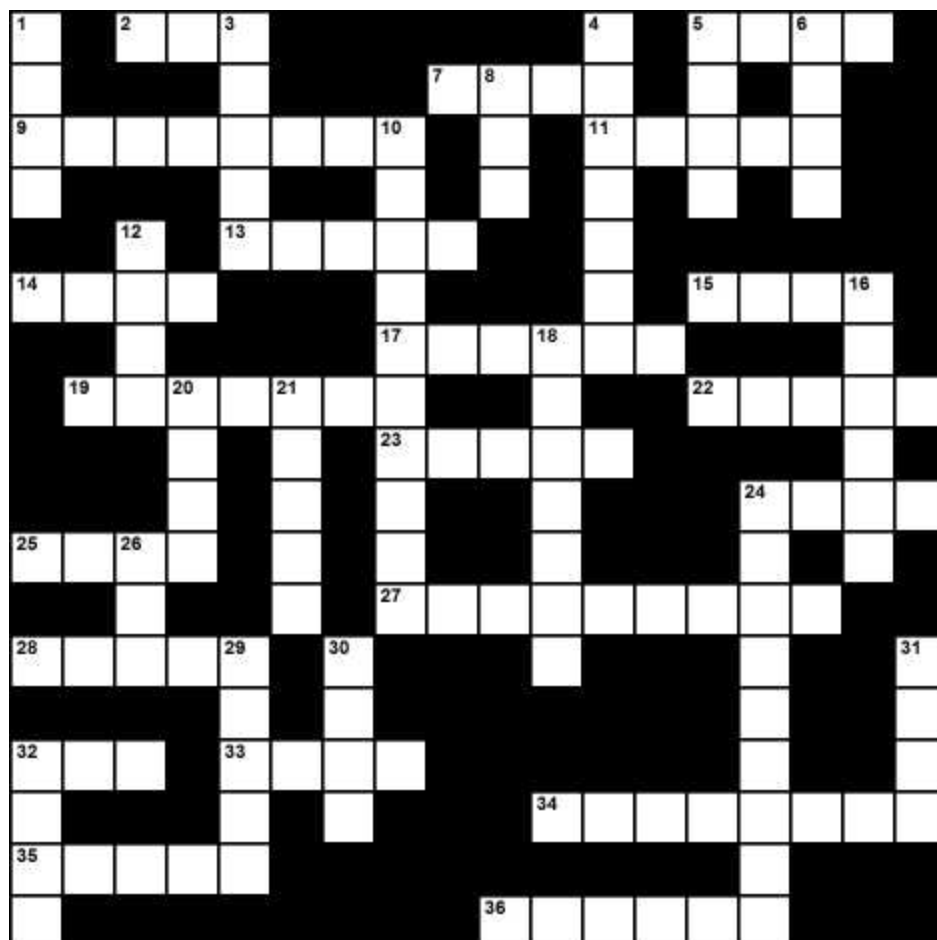


## C22 Cast Your Net, John 21:1-19, Third Sunday of Easter
