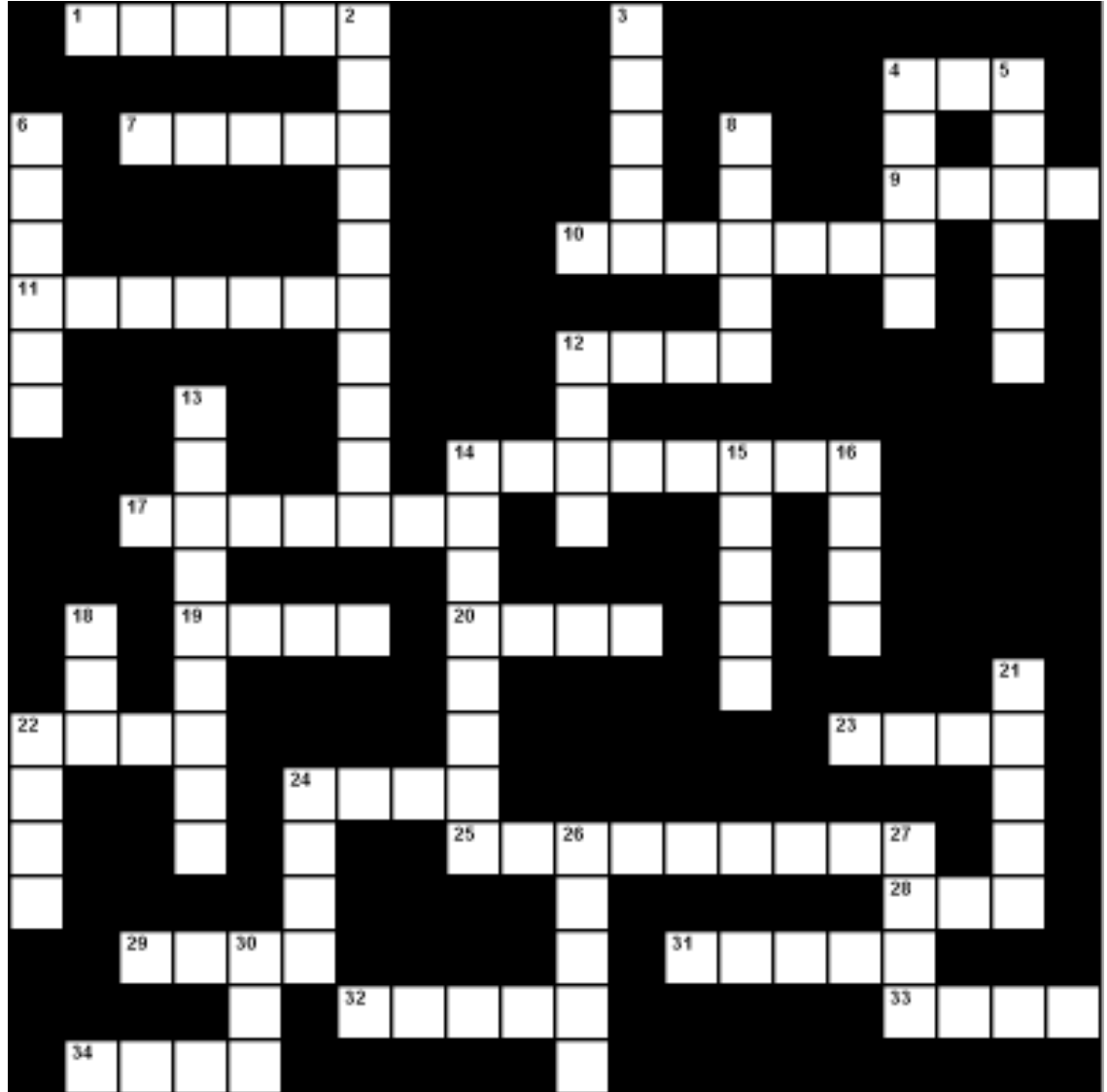


C23 My Sheep Hear My Voice, John 10:27-30, Fourth Sunday of Easter
