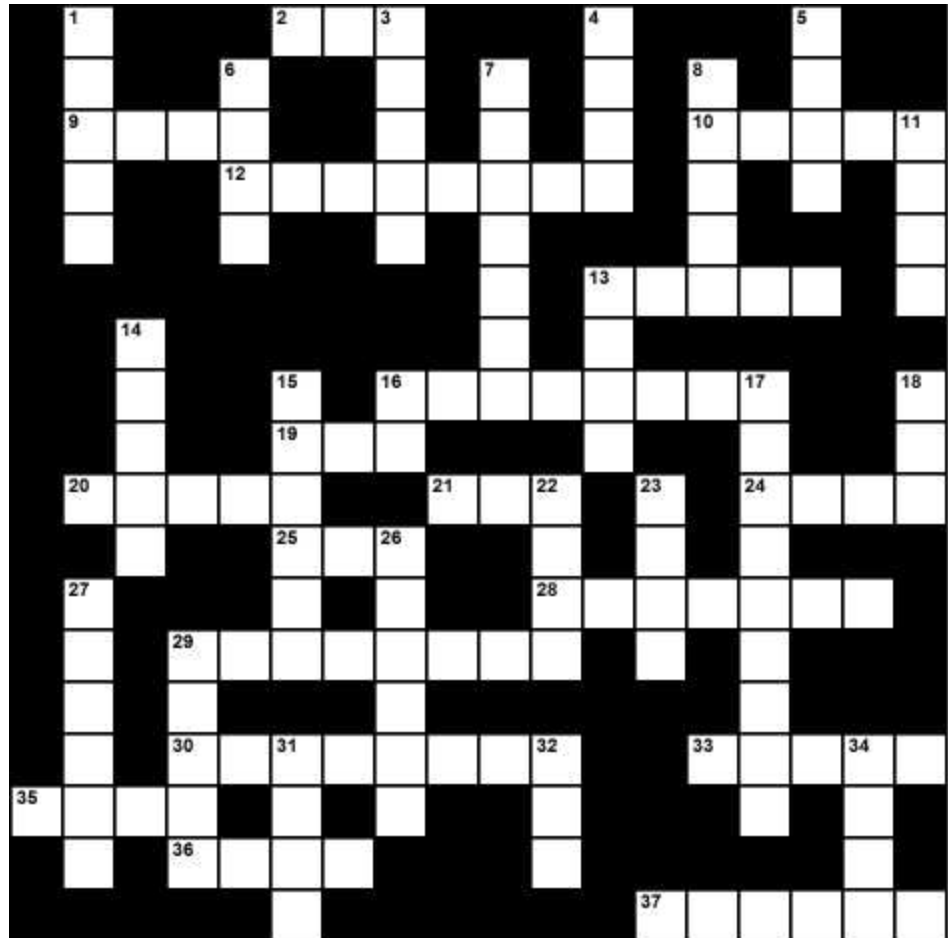


C27 Whose Sins You Forgive, John 20:19-23 or John 14:15-16, 23-26 Pentecost Sunday
