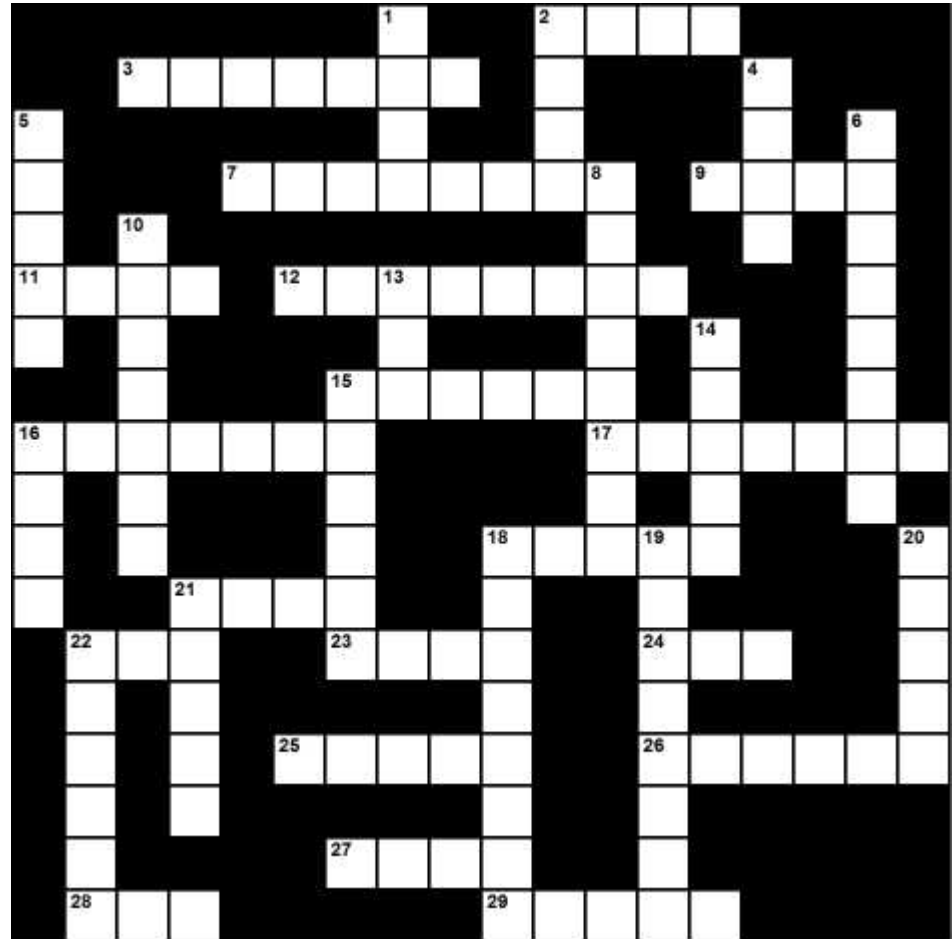


C27a The Splinter in Your Brother's Eye, Luke 6:39-45, Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time
