Second Sunday in Advent

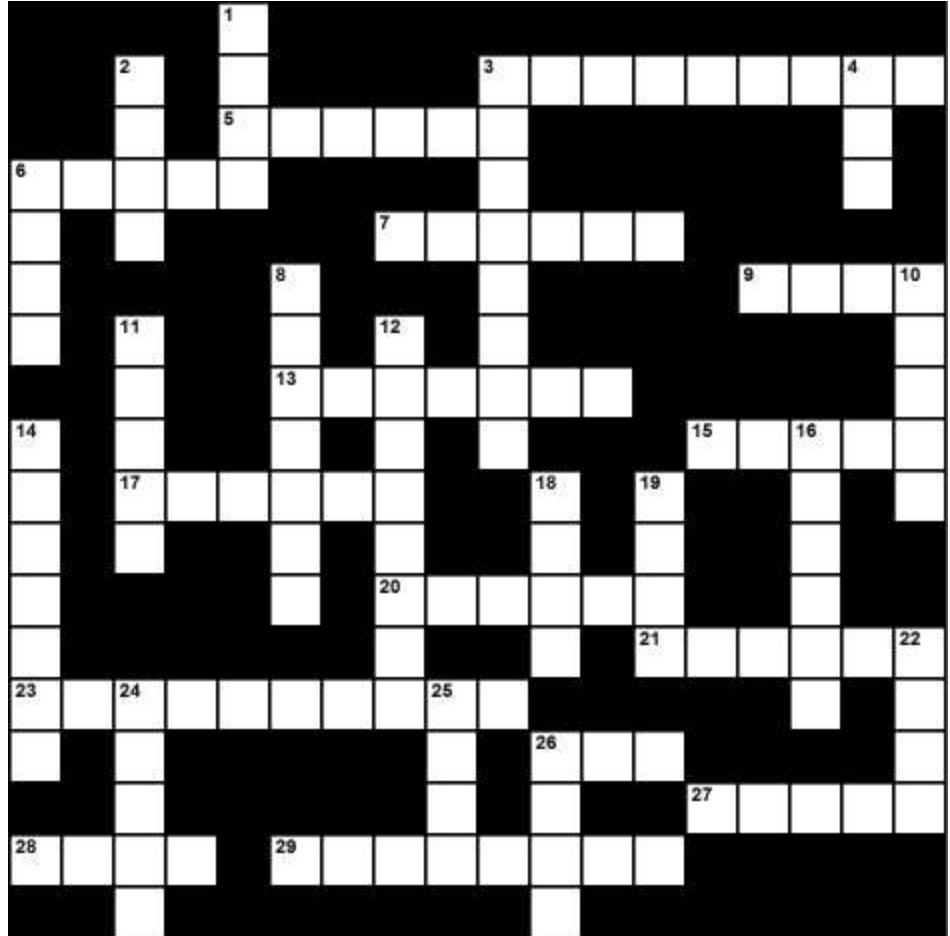
