Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time**

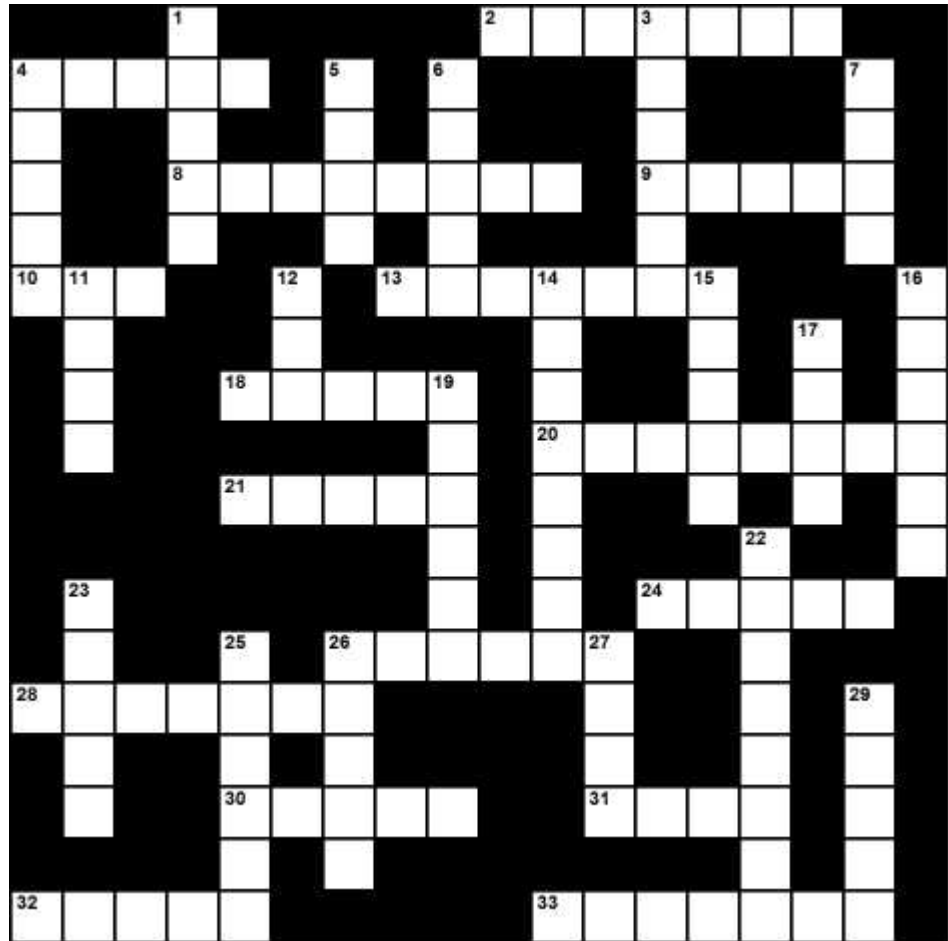
