

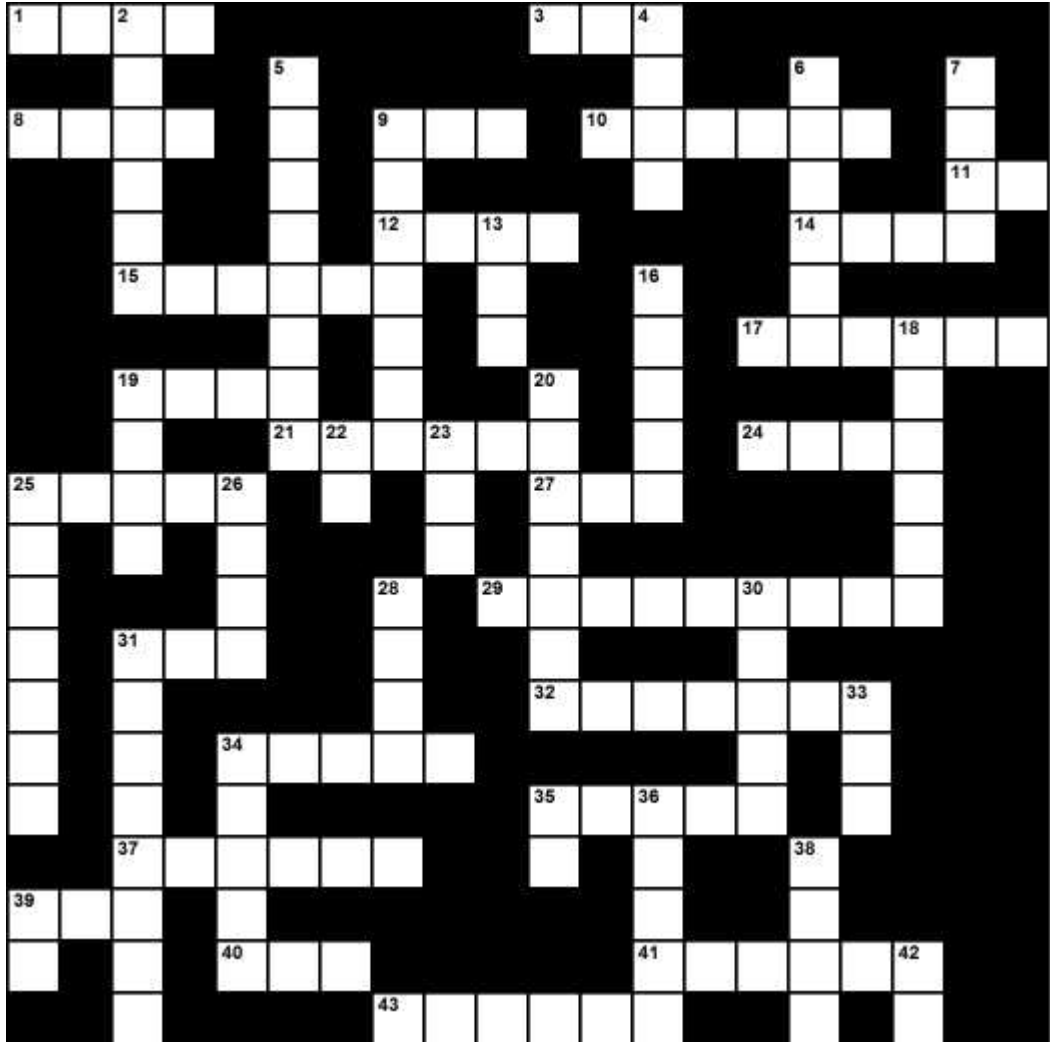
C31a Jesus Foretells His Death and Resurrection, Luke 9:18-24, Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time
