

## C31b Nativity of St. John the Baptist, Luke 1:57-66, 80, Feast of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist

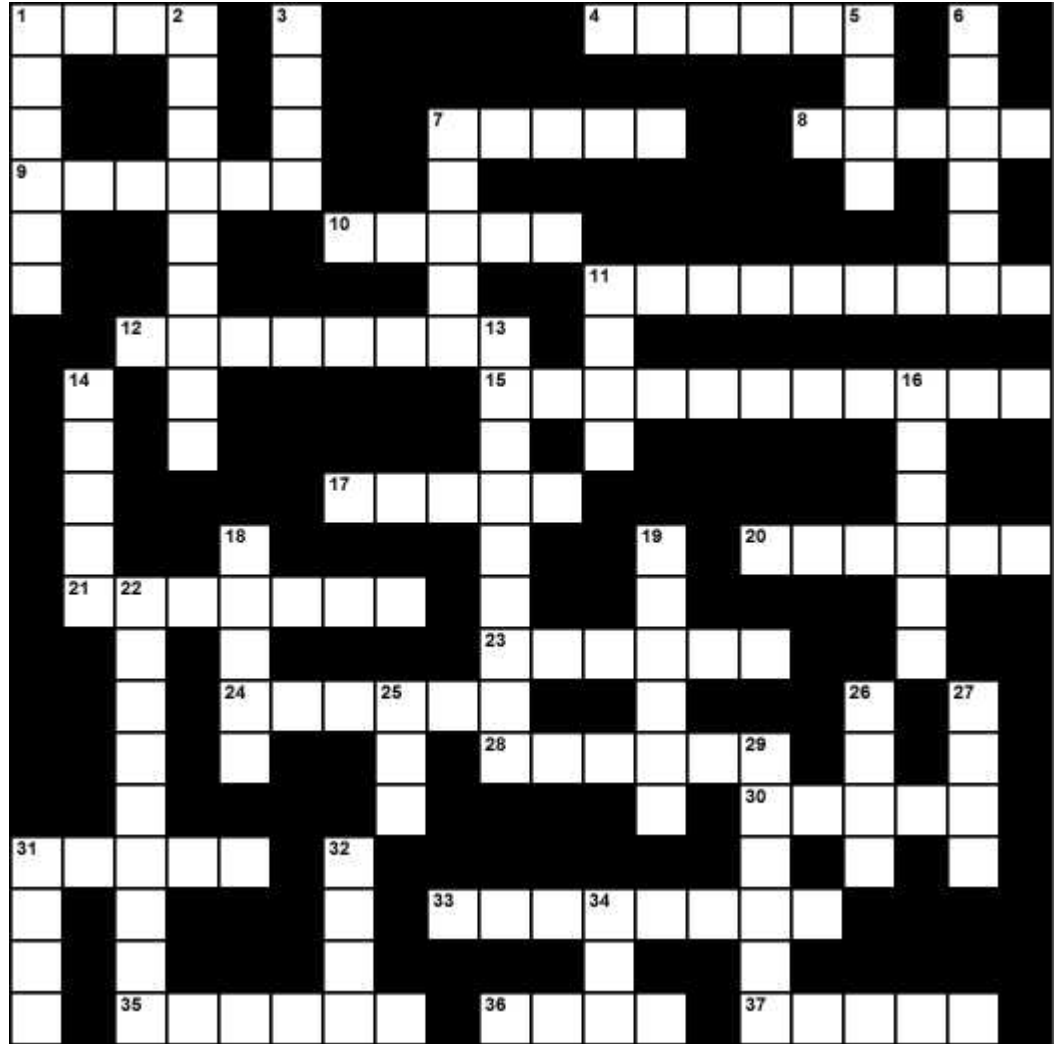
