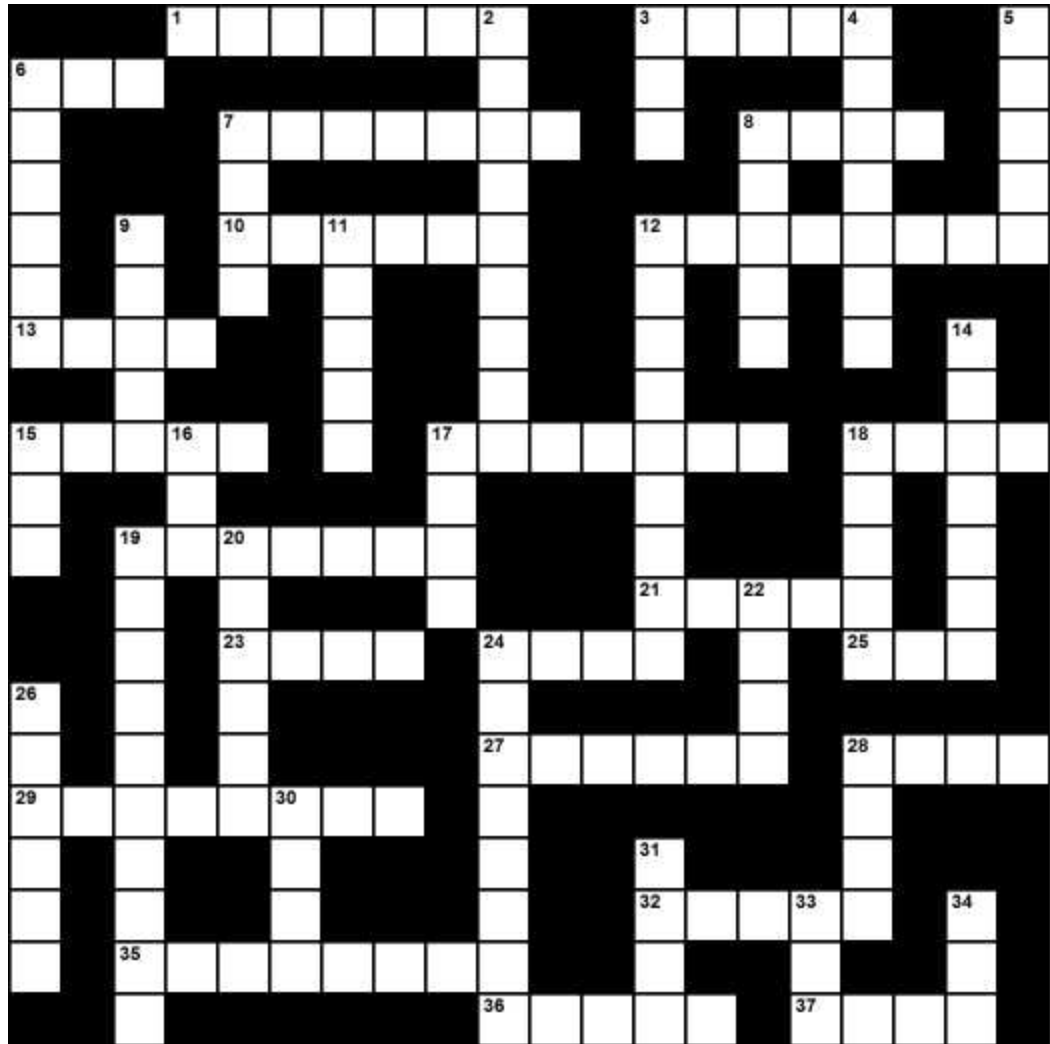


**C32 Your Name Is Written in the Heavens, Luke 10:1-12, 17-20 or 1-9,
