

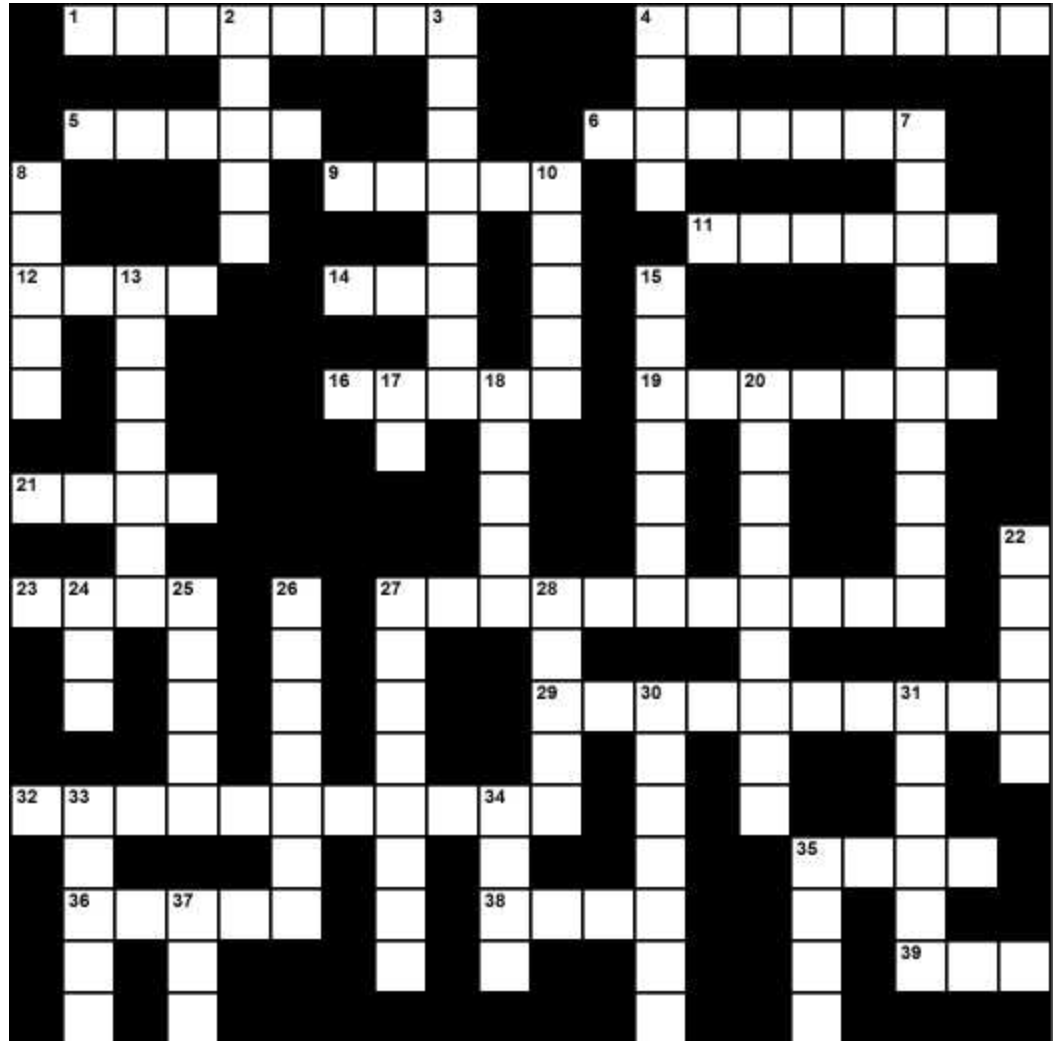
## C36 Store up Treasures for Your Soul, Luke 12:13-21 Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
