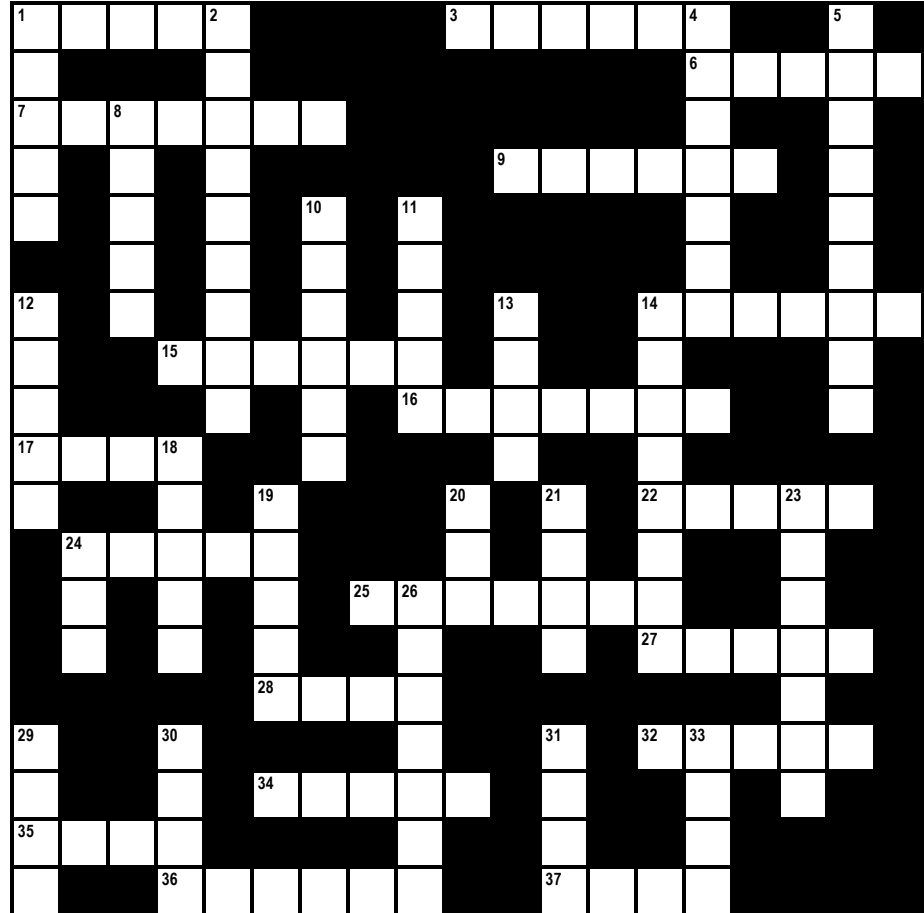


C39 Choose the Narrow Gate, Luke 13:22-30
