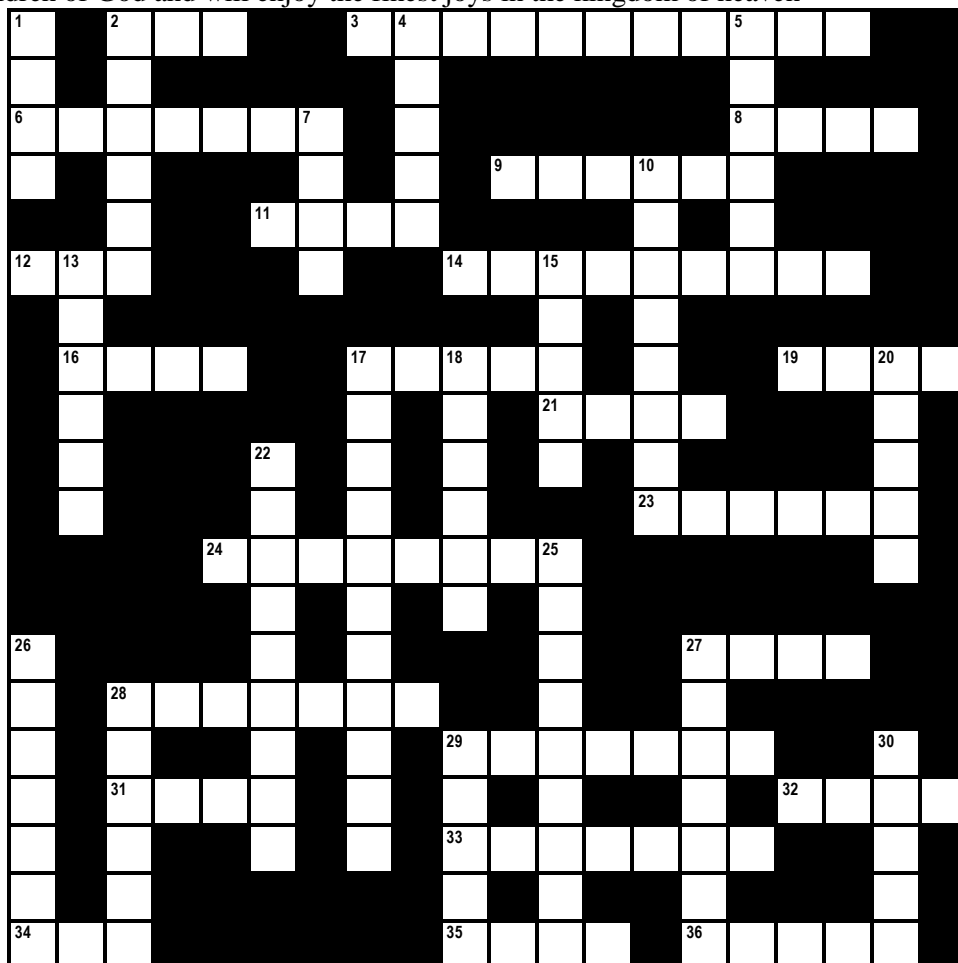


## C44 Share Your Riches with the Poor, Luke 16:19-31, Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time
