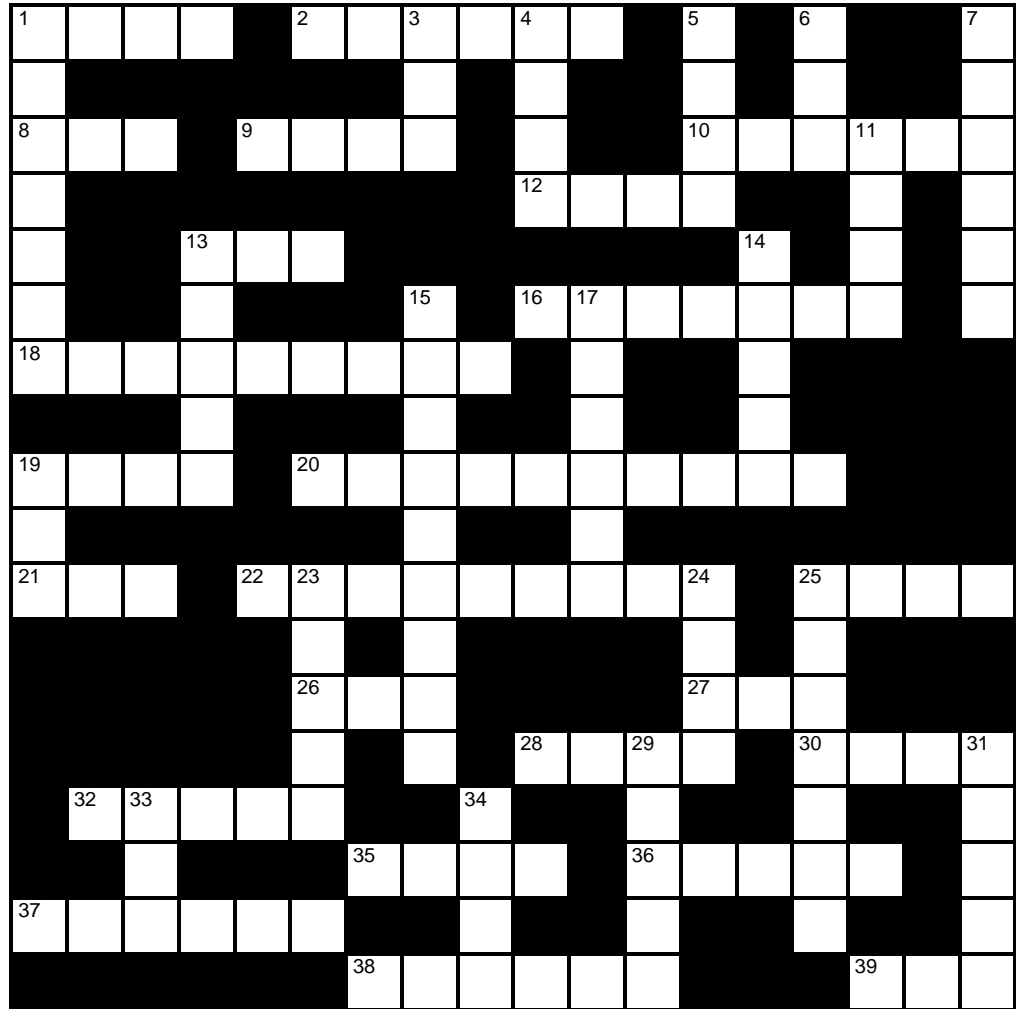


**C46 Be Filled with Thankfulness, Luke 17:11-19,
