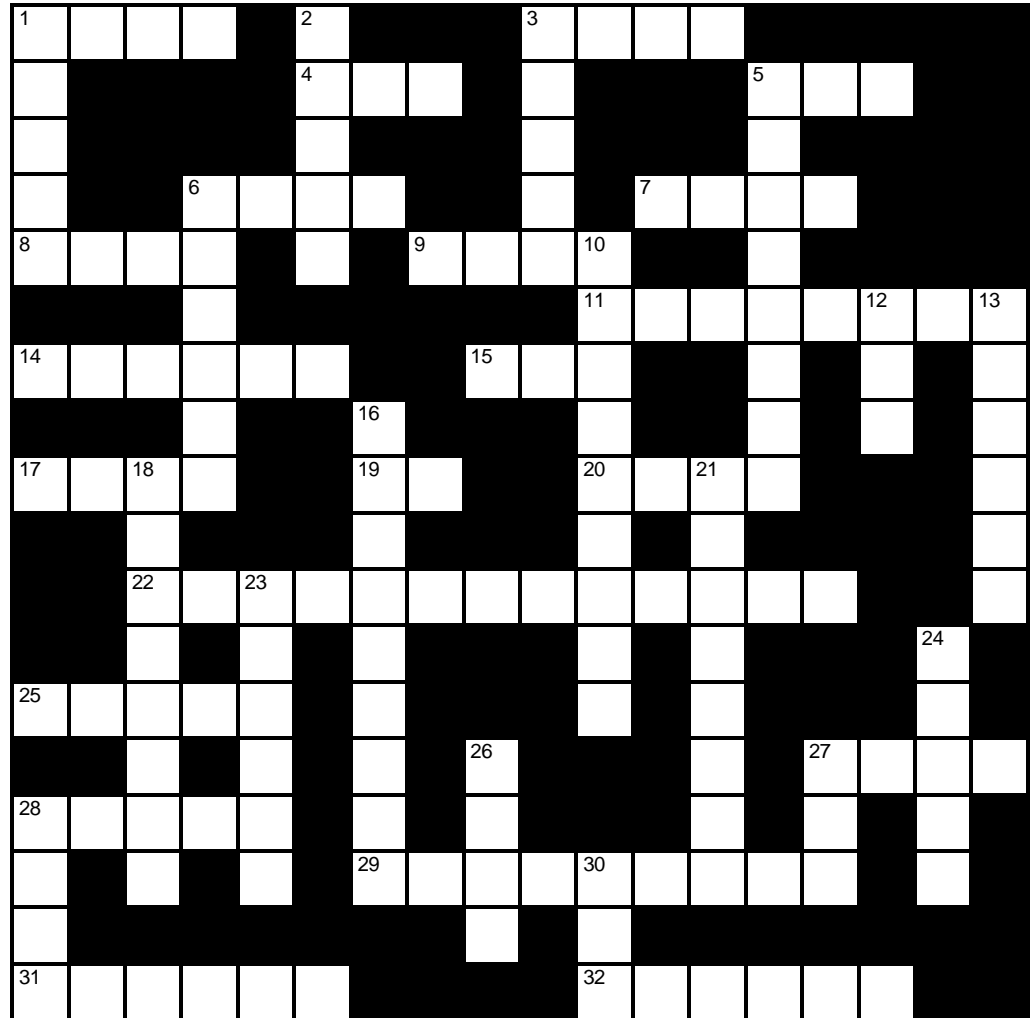


**C48 The Humble Will Be Exalted, Luke 19:1-10,
