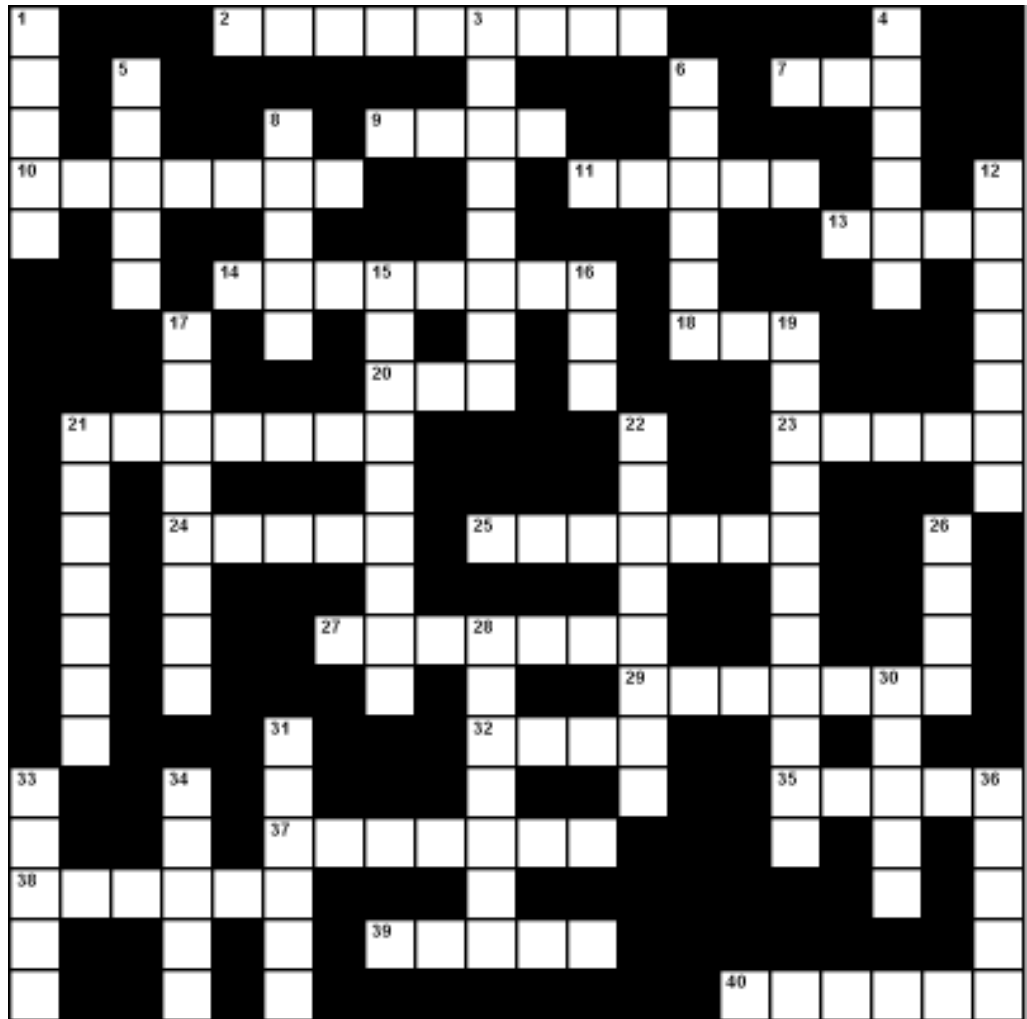


**C50 No Marriage in Heaven, Luke 20:27-38,
