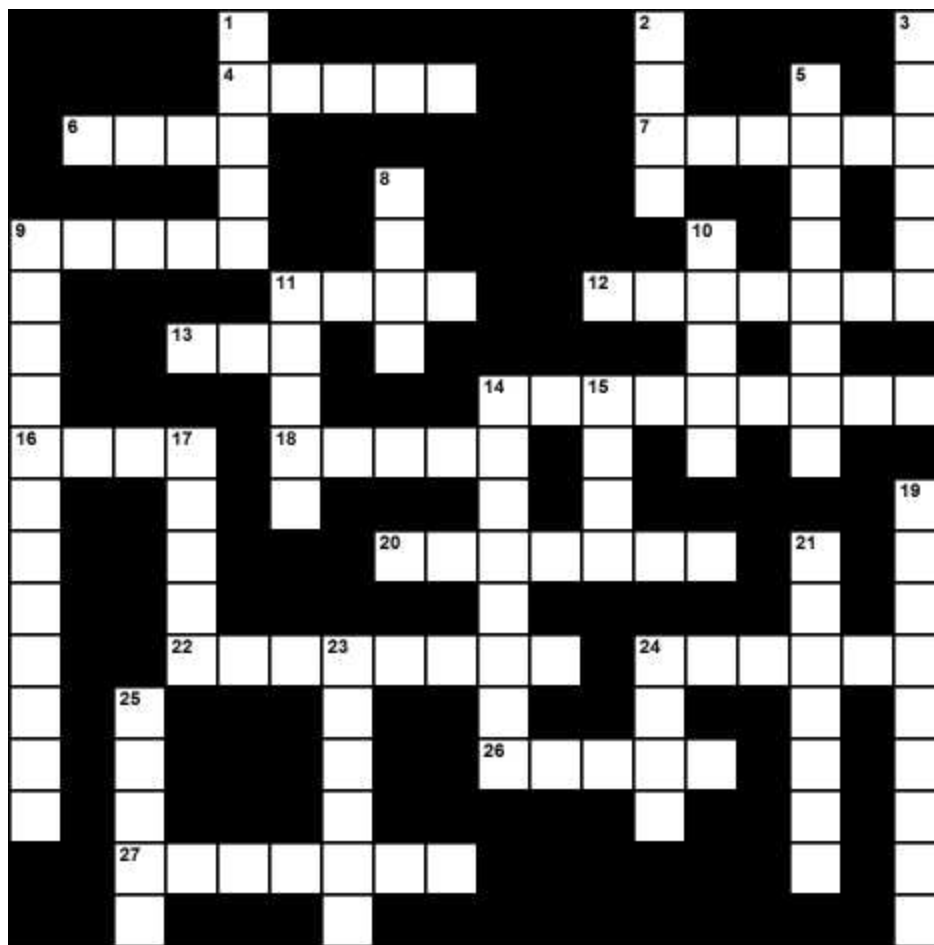


**C6 Gold, Frankincense, and Myrrh, Luke 2:1-12,
