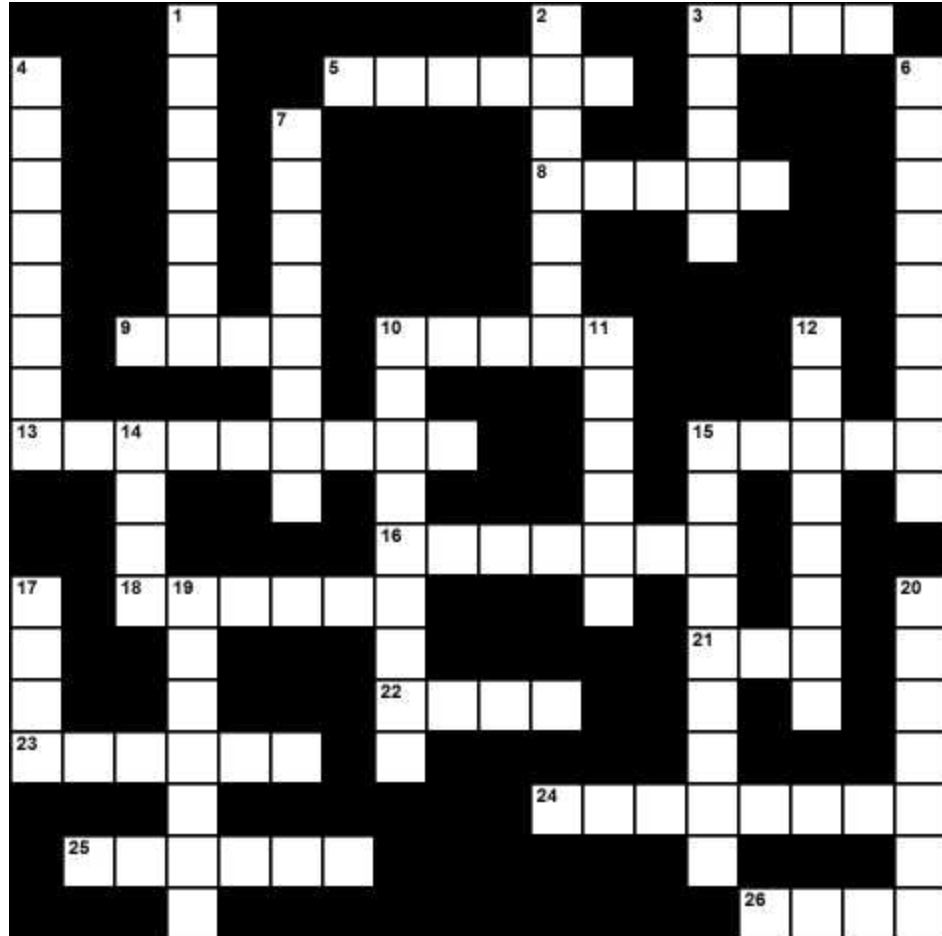


C9 Jesus Fulfills Prophecy of Isaiah, Luke 1:1-4 and Luke 4:14-21, Third Sunday in Ordinary Time
